

## COVID Administration Guidelines for Activities

While the school is under the emergency declaration the School Board has permitted administration to make decisions related to COVID matters not addressed in the handbook.

If a student has symptoms, tests positive, or has been named a close contact to a person with COVID, the student is expected to quarantine according to the CDC and RCHD guidelines and will be allowed access to Remote Learning.

During Remote Learning, student attendance will be monitored by the Attendance Clerk.

While accessing Remote Learning, students may also participate in virtual practices. This is encouraged to help in playing time decisions when students return.

If a student proactively quarantines while waiting for a close contact test result, he/she will be permitted to access Remote Learning. The student may return to school or the activity once the status of the test result is reported. In the event that a student is notified of their ability to return to activity after transportation to an away contest has departed, students may travel with a parent or guardian if there has been prior communication with the AD or other administration.

In the event of a student or staff member showing symptoms at an away event, the person will leave the event in alternate transportation. Parents will be notified and will be the first choice for alternate transportation. In the event a parent or guardian is not present, the student or staff member will be transported back to Bainville by Tanya Wilson or designee.

Additionally, all MHSА COVID guidelines will be followed.
