Bainville K-12 Schools R 1 2 3 INSTRUCTION 2312 4 5 Copyright 6 7 The District recognizes that federal law makes it illegal to duplicate copyrighted materials 8 without authorization of the holder of the copyright, except for certain exempt purposes. Severe 9 penalties may be imposed for unauthorized copying or use of audio, visual, or printed materials 10 and computer software, unless the copying or use conforms to the "fair use" doctrine. 11 Under the "fair use" doctrine, unauthorized reproduction of copyrighted materials is permissible 12 13 for such purposes as criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship, or research. 14 While the District encourages its staff to enrich learning programs by making proper use of 15 supplementary materials, it is the responsibility of staff to abide by District copying procedures 16 and obey requirements of law. Under no circumstances will it be necessary for staff to violate 17 copyright requirements in order to properly perform their duties. The District cannot be 18 responsible for any violations of the copyright law by its staff. 19 20 Any staff member who is uncertain as to whether reproducing or using copyrighted material 21 complies with District procedures or is permissible under the law should consult the 22 Superintendent.
