5 Cell Phones and Other Electronic Equipment

7 Student possession and use of cellular phones, pagers, and other electronic signaling devices on  
8 school grounds, at school-sponsored activities, and while under the supervision and control of  
9 District employees is a privilege which will be permitted only under the circumstances described  
10 herein. At no time will any student operate a cell phone or other electronic device with video  
11 capabilities in a locker room, bathroom, or other location where such operation may violate the  
12 privacy right of another person.

14 Students may not use or carry on their person cellular phones, pagers, ipods, and other electronic  
15 signaling devices on campus during regular school hours (Monday – Thursday 8:23A.M.-  
16 3:29P.M., Friday 8:23A.M.-2:26 P.M). If a teacher or other Bainville staff member instructs a  
17 student to use their cell phone for various reasons, the student may call in their presence, only.  
18 These devices must be kept out of sight, off their person, and turned off during the instructional  
19 day. Unauthorized use of such devices disrupts the instructional program and distracts from the  
20 learning environment. Therefore, unauthorized use is grounds for confiscation of the device by  
21 school officials, including classroom teachers. Confiscated devices will be returned to the  
22 **student at the end of the school day**. Repeated unauthorized use of such devices will result in  
23 disciplinary action.
